Communication/Information.


I have been working for some time on improving the systems for parental access to school information and other sources of support. I enclose lists of contact details for contacts in school, out of school and with national and local sources of support along with details of leisure opportunities you might like to explore for your child. I am grateful to Sue Welsh (Parent Governor) for her help with this last section. We have done our best to make sure that external contact numbers are up to date but these do change all the time so we apologise for any mistake. You will see that we have listed the specific responsibilities and phone numbers of office staff and senior staff in school so you can contact them directly and also included mobile numbers where staff have these. Of course parents are still free to contact reception (643 3000) should they find this more helpful. We continue to work on the school website and will make sure that these phone numbers are also on the website.

You will also see that each class now has an email address which we are encouraging parents to begin to use, where they wish, for home school communication **along with the home school book**. We feel that for many parents this is now an easier means of communication and so will be helpful for them. We will begin to do this in the New Year. Please continue to use the home school book if you prefer to do so. Class staff will be exploring ways to make the best use of this means of communication and we will welcome any comments and suggestions about this. I enclose for you an updated version of the guidelines we used last year when we piloted this method of communication. We hope that you find them helpful and self explanatory.

We are also looking into a system whereby we can contact all parents quickly in an emergency such as recent school closures through their mobile phone numbers. I will let you know more about this when it is in place. All of these systems however do depend on us keeping each other informed of any changes in e mail addresses or mobile phone numbers and I would ask for your ongoing support with this.

Please contact me or one of the parent governors if you would like to discuss this further.
